Voluntary Contributions and Charges 2023

Dear Parent/Caregivers,

The Warnbro Primary School Board has endorsed the schedule of Contributions and Charges for 2023. The schedule is broken into 4 sections and will allow you to calculate all costs that may be incurred throughout the school year.

1. Contributions:

The total amount of contributions parents/caregivers are being asked to contribute has been set at \$50 per student which is in line with the School Education Regulations 2000. The School Board would like us to inform you that this equates to \$1.25 per week over the course of a year and that all contributions are used for the direct benefit of the students. Our aim is to raise our community's contribution rate to 80% for the benefit of all our students.

While the contributions are voluntary the quality of our teaching and learning programs will be maximised when each family makes its contribution to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other sources, including the State and Commonwealth governments. The Voluntary Contribution charge allows for purchases of supplementary materials in areas such as: student workbooks; Art & Craft; Library; Science; Physical Education; Technology & Enterprise; photocopying. The table below gives you the breakdown of where we will direct your voluntary contributions to.

The approved P&C Capital Works Voluntary Contribution for 2023 is \$10.00 per student.

Warnbro Primary School has a number of options available to assist parents/caregivers making their contribution:

- Option 1 A single contribution of \$50 which can be paid directly to the school office by cash, cheque, EFTPOS, credit card or by direct deposit.
- Option 2 Four equal contributions of \$12.50 made in the first week of each term.
- Option 3 Two equal contributions of \$25.00 made in the first week of each Semester (Term 1 & Term 3).

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2. Charges for Extra Cost Optional Components

A breakdown of estimated charges for your child's participation in excursions, incursions, activities for 2023 have been included in the Charges Schedule table below. The amounts shown represent the maximum charged for scheduled activities in 2023. *The schedule includes cost associated with:*

- Specific learning activities and available to all students, but conditional on a payment being made e.g. incursions & excursions.
- Specific learning activities available to selected students, but conditional on a payment being made e.g. PEAC, Music program etc.
- Other activities available to all students but conditional on a payment being made e.g. graduation lunch, camps etc.

3. Items for Personal Use

The list of items for personal use will vary from student to student and includes:

- Pupil requirements for all students and used in lessons e.g. stationery items, calculator etc.
- Pupil requirements recommended but not essential for all students e.g. tissues, art shirt etc.
- Pupil requirements for selected students and not directly part of the educational program e.g. class photographs, Year 6 leavers shirt etc.

The Personal Items List (Booklist) is attached. These will also be available to view on the website. The school has negotiated competitive prices for materials on the list, but you are not obliged to use our supplier, however, Warnbro Primary School does receive commission for anything purchased through Campion.

Your child will need to have the listed materials each school day, it may be necessary to replace some items, such as pencils, throughout the year.

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4. Other Optional Costs

Other costs during the year may include:

- Book Fair
- Book Club
- School/class photographs
- Charity fund raising events – usually 1 per term with voluntary participation
- Class celebrations e.g. end of term/year activities etc.
- P&C fundraising events, usually 2 per term with voluntary participation
